About the training

In partnership with members of the Gypsy/Roma and Traveller community, Save the Children is delivering free cultural awareness and early years inclusion training.

We can work with you to select relevant topics. These may include:

- Culture: What is life like for Gypsies/Roma and Travellers now?
- History: How has the way of life changed over the centuries?
How did Gypsies/Roma and Travellers come to be in England?
- The legal duty of settings: Why do I need to represent Gypsies/Roma and Travellers in my setting?
- Inclusive Early Years Resources: What resources are available?
Where do I buy culturally reflective resources?
- Impact of evictions on attendance and attainment: Why do families get evicted? How will this impact on a child attending a setting?

We offer a tailored programme, flexible to the needs of your setting. This can be delivered anywhere in England. Training sessions will run with a maximum of twenty participants for a minimum of two hours. The training is free but is subject to availability.

Who should attend?

The training is intended for professionals, managers and practitioners involved in early years. This may include:

- Children's centres
- Nurseries
- Outreach workers
- Social workers
- Health professionals.
